Job Duties

- Deliver Stinger Attachments products to our dealer network throughout the lower 48
- Operate a mix of equipment including semi tractor with flatbed and dually truck with trailer
- Safely load, secure, transport, and unload equipment
- Perform pre-trip, post-trip, and routine equipment inspections
- Inspect chains, binders, straps, tarps, lights, tires, brakes, and other hauling equipment before use
- Ensure all loads are properly secured and meet company and DOT expectations before leaving
- Recheck load securement during trips as required
- Keep trucks, trailers, and hauling equipment clean, washed, greased, and ready for use
- Wash and help maintain other company equipment as needed
- Stay current on routine maintenance and coordinate needed service
- Maintain accurate service, repair, and maintenance records for trucks, trailers, and equipment
- Report mechanical or safety issues right away
- Run after parts and help with pickups or support tasks when not on the road
- Help around the yard as needed, including general cleanup, organization, and equipment readiness
- Represent Stinger professionally with dealers, customers, and vendors
- Follow DOT, FMCSA, and company safety requirements at all times

- Class A CDL and Health Card
- Must be at least 25 years old
- Minimum 5 years of verifiable driving experience
- Flatbed hauling and load securement experience is a plus
- Experience with chains, binders, straps, and general flatbed securement is a plus
- Ability to inspect loads and recognize unsafe securement issues
- Clean driving record
- Mechanical awareness and common-sense problem solving
- Ability to keep accurate service and maintenance records
- Willingness to travel and stay out overnight as needed
- Reliable, flexible, and willing to help where needed
- Forklift or equipment handling experience is a plus
